### **Comingling of Yard Waste**

Will you make sure <u>all rental housing meets basic</u> <u>housing safety codes</u>?

YES, and I also agree with OTOC about the progress we've made over these issues over the last four years. I've been proud of the city council's work on these things, together with OTOC.

When it comes to a demolition funding, when it comes to code enforcement, and when it comes to things you mentioned like the vacant and abandoned property ordinance that we passed together and the boarding house ordinance that we passed together to address these kind of issues of public safety and in quality housing throughout our city.

The vacant and abandoned property ordinance has now registered over 900 properties in the city, so that's well on its way, as is the abandoned, or the boarding house ordinance...so I think it's time to start looking at this very issue as well.

Will you assure <u>future waste management</u> <u>contracts have transparent bidding process</u> with opportunity for public comment?

Yes. This is one of the more important things a city does, is collect your trash. It's by far, our largest single contract out of any city service, over \$20 million dollars a year, in this case for 10 years. That is something that should be very transparent and involved by the public and that should be a very public process going forward.

# Do you support immediately <u>returning to the</u> <u>existing contract with Waste Management?</u>

I think I have been in competition with Councilman Gernandt over the last couple of years as being the most vocal critics of combining yard waste into the landfill. I think that's the wrong way to go.

I'm a big supporter of OmaGro. I think we need to continue our composting program in the future. Other cities have figured this out. We can too.
