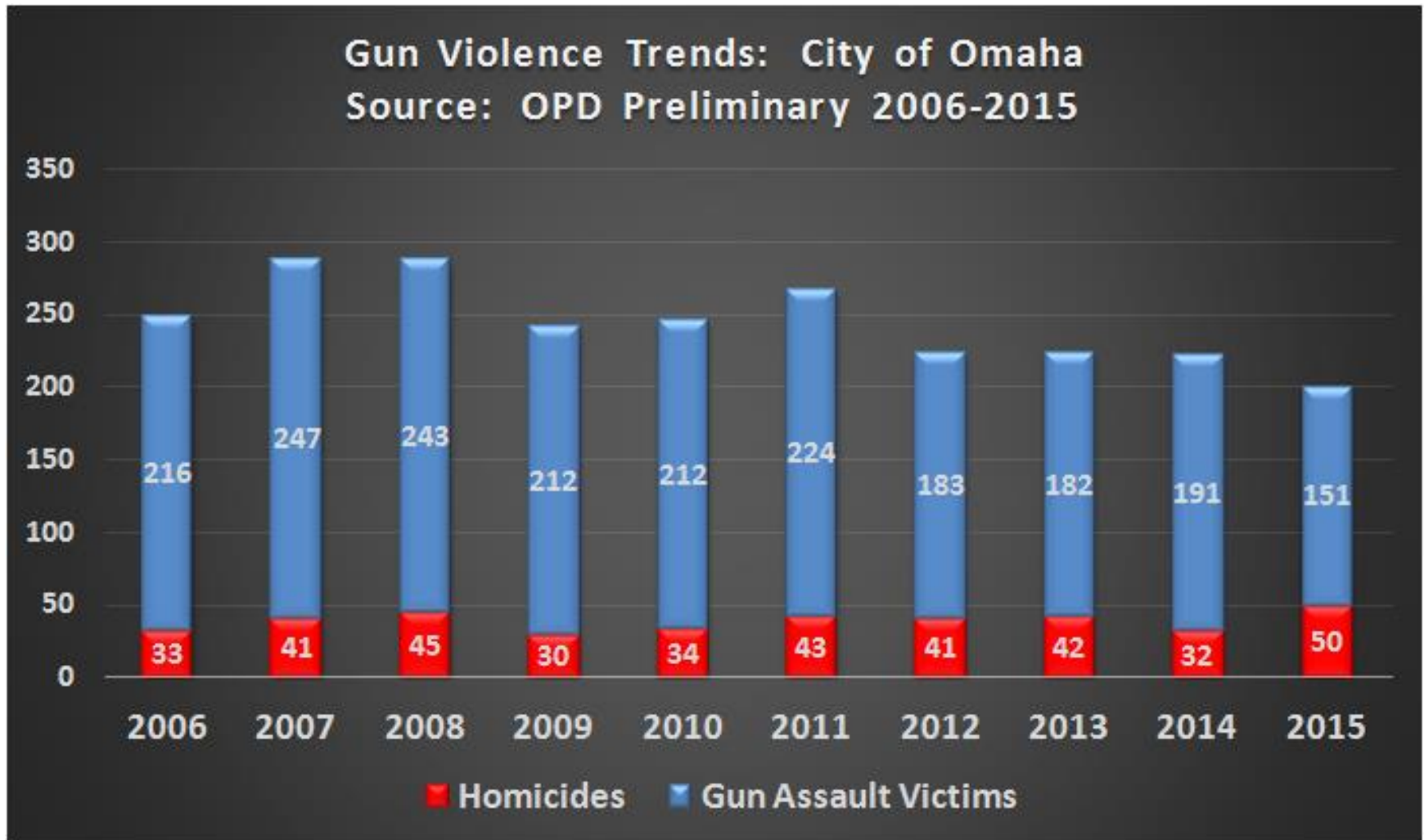
- **Collaboration – Faith, Schools, Community Orgs., Police, Govt., Law Enf.**
- **Prevention**
 - Expand Step-Up Omaha! Summer Employment and Year Round Internships/Job Fairs
 - Improve Educational Outcomes/Graduation Rates/College and Careers
 - Strengthen Families/Mentoring/Parenting/Students for Peace in each High School
 - **Research and Expand Conflict Resolution/Early Intervention/Students and Parents**
 - After School and Summer Programs/Positive Alternatives/Village Basketball Alliance
 - Community Building and Neighborhood Revitalization/Neighborhood Alliance/Village Stakeholders
 - **Pre-emptive Prayer Walks & Peace Rallies/Targeted Neighborhoods/Adopt-A-Block**
 - College Exposure, Scholarships & Support
- **Intervention Programs**
 - Gang Intervention – School and Street
 - Crisis Intervention; Prayer Walks and Peace Walks
